Tour fee includes:

Thursday 25 October:

- **Copthorne Hotel and Resort Bay of Islands**, Paihia three night's accommodation
- Accommodation includes breakfast
- **Whare Waka Café**, Waitangi Treaty Grounds pre-dinner wine and welcome dinner.
- After dinner speaker.

Friday 26 October:

- **Waitangi Treaty Grounds** day pass includes *Waitangi: Birthplace of a Nation* introductory film, an informative Guided Tour, entry to the new Te Kōngahu Museum of Waitangi and award winning exhibitions, and entry to the Treaty House, originally known as 'the Residency.'
- Talk from **Dame Claudia Orange**, researcher and concept developer for the exhibition *Ko Waitangi Tēnei - This is Waitangi* and the exhibition at the Treaty House.

Saturday 27 October:

- Return transport Kawakawa Ruapekapeka Pakaraka Waimate North Kerikeri Paihia.
- Viewing of graves of Henry and Marianne Williams in the churchyard of the **Holy Trinity Church** (1873).
- **Ruapekapeka** to visit historic Pa site
- **Te Waimate Mission**, New Zealand's second oldest building and site of the second signing of the Treaty of Waitangi - admission and tour
- Lunch at Te Waimate Mission
- The **Stone Store** and **Kemp House**, Kerikeri – admission and tour.
- Historic **Pear Tree Restaurant** Local for dinner

Sunday 28 October:

- Transport to ferry
- Return ferry ticket to **Russell**.
- **Pompallier Mission**, admission and tour.
- Lunch at **Duke of Marlborough Hotel**, New Zealand's first licensed hotel 'Refreshing Rascals and Reprobates since 1827.'

Tour fee does not include:

- Transport to and from Paihia
- Lunch and dinner on Friday
- Incidental hotel expenses
- Travel insurance

Booking Flights:

If booking flights please take note of the tour timings.

Flights to the Bay of Islands airport depart Auckland and there are only a few options each day.

On **Thursday 25 October** we will depart the hotel at 5.50pm for a welcome dinner.

The 4.30pm flight arriving Bay of Islands at 5.20pm will be JUST in time for dinner, however I suggest taking the earlier flight **arriving Bay of Islands at 2.40pm** in case of delays.

On **Sunday 28 October** the tour will end around 2.30pm (after lunch at the Duke of Marlborough Hotel **in Russell**). The best flight to aim for is the one **departing 5.45pm**. If you book the earlier flight departing at 2.05pm you will miss out on seeing Russell and lunch.

If you have time, there are buses departing downtown Auckland (Intercity) for Paihia taking about 4 hours. Alternatively you could fly to Whangarei and a bus from there would take 1.5 hours.
